## Winter Concert Information A message from Mrs. Anderson (Music Teacher)



We are excited about opening the school and inviting our families to enjoy our 2022 winter/holiday concert! This is the first time in several years that we have had this opportunity and we are so looking forward to sharing our learning with you!

Below you will find some important information pertaining to each concert. Please ensure that students come prepared the morning of the concert with what they will be wearing for the performances.

#### K-2 Concert:

This concert will be on Monday, December 19 at 6:00pm. Students are asked to be at the school for 5:30. The concert will be 30 minutes long and students will be joining each other to perform several songs. Students are asked to wear anything holiday and festive! That could be traditional colours of red and green, sparkles, Santa hat, or any outfit that is appropriate. Please know that due to limited seating and fire code, we only have room to accommodate 2 family members per student performer in the audience to see the evening concert. We will be doing a dress rehearsal in the afternoon at 1:00pm for the Gr. ¾ students, and we can accommodate a family member to watch that this time as an alternate option.

### 3-4 Concert:

This concert will be on Tuesday, December 20 at 6:00pm. Students are asked to arrive at 5:30 pm. This musical will be 30 minutes long. The grade **3 students** have the role as **snowflakes**. They should wear anything light in colour, sparkly, cream, pink, light blue, light grey, white etc. They can also make a snowflake and pin it to their shirt. Dresses, pants, sweaters, headbands are all fine. **Grade 4's are the Snirts** (snow and dirt). They can wear anything dark like black, jean jackets, leather jackets, ripped jeans, clothes that are dirty, dark sunglasses, bandanas, can have dirt on their faces, anything you can think of! Similar to the K-2 concert, due to the limited seating and fire code, we only have enough room to accommodate 2 family members per student performer. We will do a dress rehearsal in the afternoon at 1:00pm for the K-2 students, and we can accommodate a family member to watch at this time as an alternate option.

I am looking for some parents who might be able to assist with decorating the stage on the day of the concert. We are looking for anyone who can make snowflakes to hang and anyone who is able to make some holiday signs. Please let me know if you're interested and we can come up with some ideas!
